AIDS/HIV KEY DATES

Somewhere between 1914 and 1941 SIV turned into HIV when (most likely) a hunter with an open wound got infected by monkey blood probably in Cameroon

Turning point of the epidemic in the **1950s**: Virus spreads to the Brazzaville and Léopoldville (Kinshasa) in the Congo

1960s and **1970s**: UN sends many Haitians as technical experts and teachers to Zaire (DRC)

June 5, 1981: LA Times publishes: <u>Outbreaks of Pneumonia Among Gay Males Studied</u>

June 6, 1981:

San Francisco Chronicle publishes: A Pneumonia that Strikes Gay Males

July 3, 1981:

New York Times publishes: <u>Rare Cancer Seen in 41 Homosexuals</u>

January 25, 1991:

New York Times reports: <u>U.S. Reports AIDS Deaths Now Exceed 100,000</u> It does this on page 18 and compare that with <u>this !!!!</u>

As of 2022:

Around 85.6 million people have been infected with the HIV virus and around 40.4 million people have died of HIV-related causes
